# Annual Meeting and Hall of Fame Best Practices









## Meeting Notifications





#### **Notification Timeframe**

Notifications must be sent out, in writing, at minimum 15 days prior to the start of the meeting.

#### **Contact**

Notifications must be sent to the board, youth leagues, center representative and league secretaries.

### **Bylaw Proposals**

Amendments for a dues increase to the bylaws must go to the same people as above, at minimum 15 days prior to the meeting.



## **Elections**



## Elections conducted in rank order

- Presiding officer announces voting results and totals
- Vote totals should be announced and recorded in the minutes

## Delegates

- Vote must be held to elect delegates to the National Convention and State Annual meeting
- May not automatically designate delegates and just vote for alternate
- Article IX, Section C, #5 Alternates shall serve in order of their election



## Financial Best Practices





#### **Financial Reports**

Provide financial report, in writing, to every member at annual meeting



#### **Balances**

Provide membership with beginning and ending balances



#### **Types of Reports**

Profit and Loss, Balance Sheet and Statement of Cash Flows



#### **Audit not Complete**

If audit is not complete by time of meeting, provide YTD financials.






